PCM-2 Equipment:

- Stethoscope
- Pocket light
- A watch with a sweep-second hand to take a patient's pulse (*This is a watch that marks seconds, mounted concentrically with the other hands and read from the same dial. Or an alternate device that easily allows you to count a pulse while taking it.*) (i.e. **Smart Phone stopwatch.**)
- Short white coat and student name tag
- 6-inch ruler with centimeter markings
- EKG Calipers
- Sphygmomanometer (blood pressure cuff)
- Pocket vision screener
- Reflex hammer
- Tuning fork -C128
- Ophthalmoscope/otoscope. ***Periodically charge it so it is ready to use!***
- Headphones to hear heart and lung sound questions during computerized written exams
 - First set of earbuds will be provided to students, to be reserved for PCM2 exam use only; students must provide their own if lost or broken.
 - Students may use their own headphones or earbuds if they prefer. Students will need a standard size, 3.5 mm single prong jack to fit computer.
