#### WHAT ARE THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

\* Fever

\* Dry Cough

\* Productive Cough

\* Shortness of Breath

\* Fatigue or Muscle aches

REQUIRED

\* Acute Diarrhea

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

\* Please maintain 6 feet between yourself and others when not involved in patient care

## WHAT IS THE PROCEDURE FOR SCREENING AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- **WINIVERSAL SCREENING FOR ALL VISITORS AND EMPLOYEES** 
  - Screening will occur upon entrance to the hospital or any Loyola Medicine building
    - **♥** Each individual will be asked about symptoms and non-touch infrared temperature will be taken
    - Each individual will be handed a regular face mask after screening is complete to wear for the entire clinical day

      MASKS
- **WINIVERSAL MASKING FOR ALL VISITORS AND EMPLOYEES** 
  - All Loyola Medicine hospitals and clinics require that all patients,
  - visitors, colleagues and physicians wear masks in all facilities
- **\*** COVID-19 PATIENT (POSITIVE OR RULE OUT)
- \* NO MEDICAL STUDENT IS TO ENTER A COVID-19 PATIENT ROOM OR ANY ISOLATION ROOM DURING CLINICAL ROTATIONS

#### GOWN + REGULAR FACE MASK + EYE PROTECTION (WHEN AT RISK FOR CLOSE CONTACT) + GLOVES

CLOSE CONTACT CAN OCCUR WHILE CARING FOR A PATIENT, INCLUDING >

- Being within approximately 6 feet of a patient with COVID-19 for a prolonged period
- ♦ Having direct contact with sputum, serum, blood, and respiratory droplets

#### ELEVATED PRECAUTIONS FOR AEROSOL GENERATING PROCEDURES (per IDPH guidelines)

- WEAR N95 AND EYE PROTECTION OR PAPR
- **EXAMPLES INCLUDE**: bronchoscopy, BIPAP, CPAP, CPR, nebulizer treatments, noninvasive heated high flow nasal cannula devices, placing/exchanging tracheotomy, suctioning

## **EXPECTATIONS TO MAINTAIN PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

- \* The regular face mask can remain on caregiver AND can be used for up to one week unless it becomes damp, damaged, visibly soiled, or hard to breathe through
  - Masks can be stored inside of a paper bag with first and last name written on it (paper bags are not provided by the hospital)
- \* Continue to wear the same face mask throughout shift and patient care remove other PPE after patient care, and perform hand hygiene between patients (and before or after removing gloves)



## WHAT IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY DURING THE COVID-19 SITUATION

- \* Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer allowing to dry
- \* Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
